of Greer and Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, South Carolina, lying on the East side of the New Pelham Road, being all of that lot of land conveyed to me by George F. Harley by deed of even date and to be recorded herewith, and also being the same property described in three deeds to George F. Harley as shown by records in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County Deed Book 361, at pages 258 and 243, and Deed Book 290, at page 45.
