I, Ernest Miles (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Easley Lumber Company

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Forty-Five Hundred and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 4500.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: Ninety (90) Days after date, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as lot No. 2, according to plat made by W. J. Riddle, March 1949, of Pink Miles land in a section known as Free Town, said lot has the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING 83 feet South of the intersection of Arnold and Church Streets, on the West side of Church Street; thence with lot 1, S. 76-47 W. 131.4 feet to a pin; thence S. 14-03 E. 39 feet to rear corner of lot 3; thence with lot 3, N. 81-02 E. 131.3 feet to Church Street; thence with Church Street, N. 13-13 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner."
