(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Three Thousand and No/100- - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 3,000.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum, said principal machinement to be repaid: \$50.00 on June 19, 1950, and a like payment of \$50.00 on the 19th day of each month thereafter until paid in full; payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 4% per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

M. C. Office in Plat Book Pat Pages 128 and 129; this lot being also shown as Lot No. 50 on a revised subdivision of Tract No. 10, and having, according to a revised Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
