Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. DOUGLAS WILSON & CO.

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Five Thousand Fifty and 80/100 Dollars (\$ 5050.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four and one-fourth per centum (4 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Thirty-one and 31/100-----Dollars (\$ 31.31), commencing on the first day of August, 19 50, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 19 70.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain, piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the east side of Irene Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 33, on Plat of Royal Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "W", at page 25, said lot fronting a chord distance of 94.3 feet along the East side of Irene Circle, with a depth of 173.8 feet on the South side, a depth of 140.7 feet on the North side and being 100 feet across the rear.

The mortgagor covenants that until this mortgage has been paid in full he will not execute or file for record any instrument which imposes a restriction upon the sale or occupancy of the mortgaged property on the basis of race, color or creed. This covenant shall be binding upon the mortgagor and his assigns, and upon the violation thereof, the mortgagee may, at its option, declare the unpaid balance of the mortgage immediately due and payable.
