MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Elva Brooks Landrum Grady, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Elva Brooks Landrum Grady

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full

and just sum of THREE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$3,500.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of ^{five (5%)} ~~six (6%)~~ per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

THIRTY AND NO/100 (\$30.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Elva Brooks Landrum Grady

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said

Elva Brooks Landrum Grady, in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in the City of Greenville on the North side of Hampton Avenue, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Hampton avenue at a point 354 feet west of the northwest intersection of butler avenue and Hampton avenue and at corner of lot formerly owned by J. G. Landrum; and running thence with lot now or formerly owned by J. G. Landrum, N. 38-02 E. 222 feet to an alley; thence with said alley, N. 39 W. 88 feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Hattie S. Moran; thence with line of her lot, S. 33-10 W. 230.5 feet to pin on Hampton avenue; thence along the North side of Hampton avenue, S. 48-04 E. 74 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner and being the lot upon which the original mortgagor, Malinda P. Landrum, lived. Being the same lot conveyed to me by W. Inman, Master by deed dated June 19, 1950, not yet recorded."
