BEGINNING at an iron pin on line of R.O. Coker, lands and corner of properl formerly sold to me and running thence along the Coker line S. 82-35 E. 1367 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13 W. 222 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82-30 W. 1382 feet to an iron pin corner of Woodrow King land; thence with his line N. 22-20 E. 223 feet to the beginning corner, containing 6.81 acres, more or less.
