R.M.C. PARTIAL RELEASE OF LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that for value received the Shenandoah Life Insurance Company, Inc., the owner and holder of the mortgage hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured, does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release and forever discharge under lien of that certain mortgage from Earl Burns to the Shenandoah Life Insurance Company, Inc. securing the principal sum of \$4,000.00, said mortgage being dated October 12, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in volume 440 page 285, the property described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 2, as appears on a revised plat of the property of Earl Burns, said plat to be recorded herewith, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Newland Avenue, the same being the joint front corner of lots 1 and 2, said point of beginning being 76 feet from Charles Street, and running thence with Newland Avenue N. 55-14 W. 76 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 43-12 E. 103 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-33 E. 75 feet to an iron pin being the joint rear corner of lots 1 and 2; thence with the common line of lots 1 and 2, S. 43-27 W. 91.5 feet to the beginning corner.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the security of the Shenandoah Life Insurance Company, Inc. as described in the mortgage hereinabove referred to, shall in all respects, except as to the premises hereinabove described, be preserved and protected and that all lien of said mortgage except as hereby released and discharged shall remain in full force and effect and the terms and conditions and covenants thereof and of the note thereby secured, shall remain unchanged.
