(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Sixteen Hundred Fifty and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 1650.00),

with interest thereon from ~~date~~ maturity at the rate of six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$150.00 on September 1, 1950, and \$150.00 quarterly thereafter until one year after date at which time the unpaid balance will be due and payable, with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annu, to be computed and paid quarterly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, on the Western side of the Keeler Bridge Road, known and designated as Tract No. 1 of the property of J. W. Norwood, Jr., plat by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, June 22, 1940, recorded in Plat Book J at Page 225 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, same being a revised plat of part of the property of F. Jane Whitmire, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point in the middle of the Keeler Bridge Road and running thence with said road, S. 34-20 E. 695 feet to a point in Keeler Bridge Road; thence, continuing with said road, S. 20-35 E. 390 feet to a point in the Keeler Bridge Road; thence N. 83-40 W. 227 feet to a stone; thence S. 45-0 W. 242 feet to a persimmon tree; thence S. 2-25 W. 194 feet to a pine tree; thence S. 80-10 W. 405 feet to a stone; thence N. 0-10 W. 972 feet to a pine stump; thence N. 32-0 E. 500 feet to the point of beginning; and containing 15.2 Acres more or less."
