"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the Southwest side of Buncombe street, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the G. A. Norwood property according to a survey and plat of the same prepared by W. A. Hudson, Surveyor, July 18, 1908, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 265, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Buncombe street at the joint front corners of Lots 3 and 4, said pin being 238 feet from the South corner of the intersection of Buncombe street with Frank street, and running thence along the Southwest side of Buncombe street, N. 34 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corners of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 56 W. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 4, S. 34 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots 3 and 4; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 56 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to Lillian Agnes Patton by S. A. Templeton by deed dated August 6, 1548, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 356, at page 138, the said Lillian Agnes Patton having since conveyed an undivided one-half interest in
