released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The First National  
Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, as Trustee for Mrs. Lucy Poe Sparkman

all that tract or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
located on the northeast side of street formerly known as Cherry Avenue,  
said lots being designated as Lots Nos. 16 and 17 on plat of record in  
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, Page 258, and  
having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the northeast side of Cherry Avenue, corner of  
Lot No. 18 and running thence with line of said lot, N. 43-19 E. 140.2  
feet to a stake; thence S. 46-34 E. 50 feet to a stake at the corner of  
Lot No. 15; thence with the line of Lot No. 15, S. 43-19 W. 140.2 feet
