Moffitt, her heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, near Welcome School, just off the White Horse Road, containing Five and Twenty-nine one hundredths acres (5.29) being part of tract no. 15 of the J. R. Yown lands (see plat recorded in Plat Book "H", at page 49) and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of schoolhouse property, and running thence with line of H. K.
