I, M. G. Proffitt (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The South Carolina National Bank of Greenville, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eighty-two Hundred Fifty & No/100

DOLLARS (\$8,250.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: Six Months after date.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southern side of Rock Creek Drive, in the City of Greenville, being a portion of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 as shown on Plat of property of Elizabeth G. McCall, made by Dalton & Neves in April 1940, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Rock Creek Drive at corner of property now or formerly owned by Edwin B. Weaver, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 18-33 E. 130.2 feet to a stake in branch; thence with the branch, S. 74-13 W. 64 feet to a stake, the original corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence continuing with said branch, S. 78-10 W. 18 feet to a stake; thence N. 18-33 W. 122 feet, more or less, to a stake on Rock Creek Drive; thence with the Southern side of Rock Creek Drive, N. 74-03 E. 82 feet to the beginning corner."
