Traxler, deceased, their heirs, successors and assigns, all those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northwestern side of Trails End, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #199 and the Southerly and adjoining one-half of Lot #200, according to plat of Cleveland Forest, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in May, 1940, as revised through October, 1949, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M, at page 57, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
