well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand & No/100 (\$10,000.00) - - - - - Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

\$79.08 on the first day of each month commencing December 1, 1950; payments to be applied first to interest, balance to principal. Balance due 15 years from date,

with interest from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

Shenandoah Life Insurance Co., Inc., its successors and assigns, forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being situate on the East side of Meyers Court and being known and designated as Lots #25 and 26, of Section "C" in a subdivision known as Parkvale, and shown on plat by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July, 1940, and being more particularly described according to survey and plat by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, October, 1950, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Meyers Court, front corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence with said Court or Street, N. 2-22 E. 140 feet to an iron pin in line of property of O'Neal; thence with his line, S. 84-30 E. 405 feet to center of a branch, an iron pin being 15 feet West of the center of said branch; thence down and with the center of said branch as the line, a traverse line being S. 52-37 W. 210.2 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence with line of said Lots, N. 83-43 W. 238 feet to the beginning.
