Norwood, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being at the Southeast intersection of Clark Street and Cook Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as all of Lot 19 on Map No. 1 of Nicholtown Heights, prepared by C.M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, in June 1922, and revised by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in March 1941, which revised plat is recorded in Plat Book "M", at page 4, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Cook Avenue (sometimes referred to as "A" Avenue) at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 18, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N 89-15 E 110 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint rear lines of Lots 20 and 19, S 0-45 E 40.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Clark Street (sometimes referred to as "G" Street); thence along the North side of said street, S 89-15 W 110 feet to point at the intersection of said street with the East side of Cook Avenue; thence along the East side of Cook Avenue, N 00-45 W 40.2 feet to point of beginning.
