Whereas, We, the said Ed Johnson and Alice Johnson

in and by our certain premissory note in writing, of even date with these

Railway in the Town of Mauldin, SC, adjoining lands of Watson Greene, Mr. Austin, and others, containing 2 acres more or less according to a plat of survey made by W. J. Riddle in July 1948, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the right of way of the C. & W. C. railway and joint corner with Watson Greene and running thence along Greene line N. 83-08 E. 625.5 ft. to iron pin on Austin line; thence along Austin line S. 0-25 E. 75 ft. to iron pin; thence still along Austin line S. 4-11 E. 287.2 ft. to iron pin on Shaver line; thence along Shaver line S. 80-13 W. 23 ft. to iron pin; thence N. 41-21 W. 365.8 ft. to stake; thence S. 76-44 W. 350.7 ft. to stake on C. & W.
