well and truly indebted to

Dollars, in and by certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

\$35.00 on the 15th day of each month hereafter commencing March 15, 1951; payments to be applied first to interest, balance to principal. Balance due five years after date with the privilege to anticipate part or all after one year,

with interest from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said W. Clyde Hensley and Ethel B.

Hensley in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. E. Robinson, as Trustee under the B. M. McGee Will, his successors and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Green Street and Chicora Avenue (also known as Palmetto Avenue), and being known and designated as Lot #1, Block Y of Riverside as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "A", Page 323, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Chicora Avenue and Green Street, and running thence along Green Street in a Southerly direction 125 feet to a point on the Northern side of an alley; thence along the North side of said alley in an Easterly direction 50 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot 2 in a Northerly direction 125 feet to a point on the South side of Chicora Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence along the South side of Chicora Avenue in a Westerly direction 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagors by William J. Long and Louise Long by deed of even date herewith and this mortgage is given to secure funds with which to pay the unpaid portion of the purchase price.
