We, Terry Williams and Lucy Williams

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eighteen Hundred and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 1800.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lots 46, 47, and 48 of Block B, as shown on a plat of Jefferson Heights, recorded in Plat Book C at Pages 34 and 35, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Third Avenue, joint front corner of lots 45 and 46, and running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 81-40 W. 87.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0-30 W. 76.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 48 and 49; thence with joint line of said lots, N. 81-40 E. 87.5 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Third Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 0-30 E. 76.5 feet to the point of beginning."

Being the same premises conveyed to Lucy Williams by Park D. McKinney by deed recorded in Volume 298 at Page 365, the said Lucy Williams having conveyed a one-half undivided interest therein to Terry Williams by deed to be recorded.
