WHEREAS:

I, ROBERT C. DILLARD,

of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

LIBERTY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Ninety-one Hundred and No/100----- Dollars (\$ 9100.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Liberty Life Insurance Company in Greenville, S. C., or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-eight and 05/100----- Dollars (\$ 48.05), commencing on the first day of April, 1951, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of March, 1976.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina;

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 29, on plat of Crestwood, Inc., made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, February 29, 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at page 189, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. K. Campbell, Surveyor, January 31, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive at joint front corner of Lots 27 and 29, and running thence with the line of Lot 27, S 39-15 W 210.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N 5-45 W 160 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 30, N 65-05 E 134.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of South Estate Drive; thence along the Southwest side of South Estate Drive, S 30-25 E 65 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor by deed of L.A. Moseley, of even date, to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
