Greenville, and in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Arlington Avenue, and being known and designated as the southern portion of Lot No. 12, of Block A, of a subdivision known as Pendleton Street Realty Association, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at pages 122 and 123, and having, according to a survey made on August 14, 1946 by Pickell and Pickell, Engrs., the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
