----- Dollars (\$ 8300.00), with interest from date at the rate of **Four** per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable

at the office of **Liberty Life Insurance Company**

in **Greenville, S. C.**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of **Fifty and 30/100-----**

----- Dollars (\$ 50.30), commencing on the first day of **May**, 19 **51**, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **April**, 19 **71**.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina;

All that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate on the Northwest side of Rockwood Drive, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 35 on plat of Rockwood Park, made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, August 24, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "S", at pages 168 and 169, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. W. Dalton, Surveyor, March 17, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

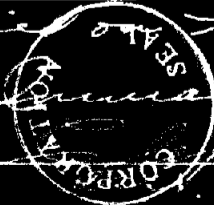
