AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note and mortgage given by Henry J. Winn to Liberty Life Insurance Company, dated March 5, 1948, covering property in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, said mortgage being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 382, at page 227, the sum of Four Thousand and No/100(\$4,000.00)Dollars, with interest thereon from March 5, 1951, and

WHEREAS, Henry J. Winn is still the owner of the premises covered by the above mentioned property, and

WHEREAS, the said Henry J. Winn has requested that Liberty Life Insurance Company extend the time of payment of said note as herein-after provided, which said Liberty Life Insurance Company has consented to do.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, I, Henry J. Winn, do hereby agree to pay to Liberty Life Insurance Company the sum of Four Thousand and No/100(\$4,000.00)Dollars, the balance remaining on said note, as follows:

The sum of Four Thousand and No/100(\$4,000.00)Dollars to be paid on March 5, 1955, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Four and one-half (4½%) per centum per annum, to be computed and paid June 5, 1951 and quarterly thereafter, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal.

Privilege is granted the borrower to pay all or any part of the principal on any interest payment date.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD that all other terms, stipulations and conditions contained in the said note and mortgage shall remain as written except as herein modified.
