All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County
of Greenville and State of South Carolina, known and designated as
Lot No. 12 on plat of property of the Robert Miller estate, made for
Jellie M. Turrentine and Mrs. S. C. Thompson by H. S. Brockman,
surveyor, dated July 12, 1948, recorded in the Office of the Clerk
of Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances,

BEING at a stake joint corners of lots 25, 11 and 12 as shown
