"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Washington Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 8, of Block N, which point is 58 feet North of the Northeast corner of the intersection of Oconee Street with Washington Avenue, and running thence along the East side of said Washington Avenue, N. 22-10 W. 58 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Washington Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 10; thence N. 71-0 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 10; thence S. 22-10 E. 58 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 8, of Block N; thence along the line of that lot, S. 71-00 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
