bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

being known and designated as a tract of land containing 11.2 acres, more  
or less, according to a survey made by J. Mac Richardson on April 6, 1951

Cannon by Joe P. Jameson and being a part of the Arch Jameson Estate.
