(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Four Thousand and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 4,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being a portion of Lot No. 11 in Lowndes Hill Orchard Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book E at Page 13, being also shown as Lot 16-1, Block 1, Page W.O. 12 of the Greenville County Block Book, and having, according to a Plat of the Property of William M. Forest made by Piedmont Engineering Service March 26, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on the West side of Woods Lake Road at the joint corner of property now or formerly owned by Richard F. Watson, Jr., and running thence with the line of said property, N. 61-20 W. 525 feet; thence due South 144 feet; thence S. 65-41 E. 505.6 feet to Woods Lake Road; thence with Woods Lake Road due North 100.5 feet to the point of beginning."
