C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being near the Town of Greer (now in the New City Limits of Greer) being known as lots 1 and 2 of the G. W. Neely Estate by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated March 24, 1937, lot No. 2 having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of lot No. 1 and running thence along the Pelham Road N. 0.30 E. 55 feet to corner of lot No. 3; thence along the line of lot No. 3, N. 82.55 W. 139.9 feet to iron pin; thence S. 20.30 W. 55.8 feet to corner of lot No. 1; thence along the line of lot No. 1 S. 82.55 E. 158.8 feet to the beginning corner, this being all of the same lot of land conveyed to 1 by E.
