SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said George W. Gary
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to William Maxwell and Buster Lewis

in the full and just sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00)

, to be paid October 1, 1951, with the right to
anticipate the whole or any part thereof,

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid October 1, 1951

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Maxwell and Buster Lewis, their heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 6 of the property William Maxwell and Buster Lewis located on a Country Road, which leads from the Piedmont Highway to Lakeside, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of said Country Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 and running thence N. 3-30 E. 435.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 66-44 E. 53 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-26 E. 215.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-30 W. 214.7 feet to an iron pin in the center of said country road; thence along the center of said country road to the point of beginning, the same being known and designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 6.
