All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with dwelling and improvements thereon, in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds to wit; BEGINNING at a stone on Pine Ave., 2.70 chains from corner of Pine Ave. and Road leading to Pelzer, and running thence S. 20-3/4 W. 7.75 chains to a stone; thence S. 86 W. 4.00 chains to a stone; thence N. 20-3/4 E. 7.75 chains to a stone on Pine Ave.; thence with Pine Ave. N. 86 E. 4.00 chains to the point of beginning, containing three and five one-hundredth (3.05) acres, more or less.
