Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being three miles West of the City of Greenville on the West side of Gentry Street, known as Lot No. 4 of Block #2 of Hoke's Subdivision, as recorded in Plat Book "C" at page 54 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Gentry Street at the intersection of First Street and running thence with First Street, N. 56 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 34 E. 50 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 6; thence with the line of Lot No. 6, S. 56 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Gentry Street; thence with the West side of Gentry Street, S. 34 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
