MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Joseph B. Crumpton

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Joseph B. Crumpton

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand and No/100-----(\$ 8,000.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of ~~six (6%)~~ four (4%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of Forty-eight and 48/100-- -- -- -- -- (\$48.48) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Joseph B. Crumpton

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said Joseph B. Crumpton in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 6-E, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision of the property of Talmer Cordell and James H. Campbell according to a plat thereof originally prepared by C. C. Jones in October, 1950 and revised and replatted by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, in March, 1951 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Z, at page 175, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the western corner of the intersection of Dargan Avenue with Florida Avenue Extension, and running thence along the south side of Florida Avenue Extension, S. 80 W. 156.8 feet to a pin; thence S. 73-37 W. 19.5 feet to a pin, corner of Welcome School lot; thence along the line of that lot, S. 14-13 E. 95.5 feet to the rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of that lot, N. 75-47 E. 175 feet to a point on the western side of Dargan Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the western side of Dargan Avenue, N. 14-13 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Local Home Builders, Inc. by deed not yet recorded.

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
