To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said G. H. Moon,  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to The Peoples' National Bank,  
as Trustee for Maybelle Hatch Foundation,  
in the full and just sum of Five Thousand and No/100 (\$5,000) Dollars

to be paid \$55.52 per month, beginning one month  
from date hereof, and a like amount on the same day of each and every  
month thereafter until paid in full, all payments to be applied first  
on interest and then on principal until paid in full,

with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
