with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal: and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All those two adjoining tracts, parcels or lots of land with buildings thereon in
Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the east side
of road leading from Fork Shoals to Fountain Inn, more fully described as follows:

NO. 1 BEGINNING at iron pin in Fork Shoals road, Fork Shoals Cotton Mill and J. P.
Willis corner, thence along the Terry Shop road S. 63½ E. 11.50 chains to stake in
road; thence S. 13¼ W. 20.66 to stone across branch; thence S. 65 W. 3.60 to stone;
thence N. 13¼ E. 16.27 to stone; thence N. 63½ W. 10.45 to middle of said Fork Shoals
road (stone on bank 25 links from corner); thence N. 28 E. 7.00 along said road to
beginning corner, containing twelve and ninety-two one-hundredths (12.92) acres,
more or less, bounded by lands now or formerly of Fork Shoals Cotton Mills, Jas. P.
Willis, and others.

NO. 2 BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of the road, corner of Tract No. 9 of
the Cedar Falls Light and Power Co. lands, sold to W. A. Hopkins and running thence
with the line of said tract No. 9, S. 30 W. 589 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13¼ E.
600 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence with the said road S.
63½ E. 173 feet to the beginning corner.
