All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southeast side of Rutherford Road (sometimes called Camp Road), being shown as all of Lots 12 and 11 and part of Lot 10 of Block B, on revised plat of Northgate, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "M", page 13, and having according to said plat and according to a plat of the property of Paul J. Oeland, et al, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in February 1947, the following metes and bounds,
