TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Robert Grady Coleman (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Citizens Lumber Company (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Forty-Two Hundred Fifty and No/100

DOLLARS (\$4250.00)

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$42.50 on December 1, 1951, and a like payment of \$42.50 on the 1st day of each month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, being known and designated as lot 74, on plat recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA at Page 59, being on Merrilat Avenue, between Earnshaw Avenue and Callahan Avenue in Sans Souci Heights, on the New Buncombe Road, about three miles North of the City of Greenville, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern edge of a 3 foot sidewalk running along Merrilat Avenue, said pin being the joint front corner of lots 74 and 75; thence along the northern edge of said sidewalk, S. 59-02 W. 69 feet, to an iron pin, joint front corner of lots 73-A and 74; thence along the eastern line of lot 73-A, N. 21-49 W. 107.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 73-A and 74; thence N. 64-02 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; joint rear corner of lots 74 and 75; thence along the western line of lot 75, S. 29-02 E. 101.5 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by Ben F. Perry by deed to be recorded."
