WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Forty Five Hundred and No/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$4,500.00) with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State, of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southeast side of High Hill Street, shown as Lot 60 on plat of Augusta Road Hills, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "B", at pages 56 and 57, said lot fronting 79.7 feet along the Southeast side of High Hill Street, running back to a depth of 165 feet on the Southwest side, to a depth of 174.5 feet on the Northeast side of said lot along Low Hill Street and being 87.5 feet across the rear.
