To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I, Lila F. Roach

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Lila F. Roach hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to William S. Serrine,

hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of One Thousand

DOLLARS (\$ 1,000.00) to be paid \$150.00 April 1, 1952; \$150.00 October 1, 1952; \$150.00 April 1, 1953; \$150.00 October 1, 1953; \$200.00 April 1, 1954; and \$200.00 October 1, 1954

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six (6%)

percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection; or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William S. Serrine,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, situate on the north side of Fairview Drive Road and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Fairview Drive Road, thence S. 57° W. 3.90 chains to iron pin on said road; thence N. 11° E. 3.93 chains to iron pin on Greenbush Cleveland line, thence S. 74° W. 3.50 chains to iron pin 3 rods containing 2.50 acres more or less according to a survey made by J. Earle Freeman December 7, 1943.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by T. W. Fleming by deed dated December 9, 1943 and recorded in deed volume 259 page 212 of the S. C. Office for Greenville County.
