SEND GREETING:

Whereas, the said Cely Brothers Lumber Company, Inc. a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in and by its certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, is well and truly indebted to Roy Thomason in the full and just sum of Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00)

, to be paid six months from the date hereof

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid at maturity until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land located in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as lot no. 3 according to plat of the property of Roy Thomason, made by Dalton and Neves, Surveyors, March 1951, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Z" at page 181, and said lot being more particularly described, according to said plat, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Phoenix Avenue at the joint front corners of lots nos. 2 and 3 and running thence with the line of lot no. 2, N. 61-57 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence running with the line of lot no. 7, S. 28-03 E., 68 feet to an iron pin on said line, joint rear corner of lots nos. 3 and 4; thence running with the line of lot no. 4, S. 61-57 W., 160 feet to an iron pin on Phoenix Avenue, joint front corner of lots nos. 3 and 4; thence running with Phoenix Avenue N. 28-03 W., 68 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of lots nos. 2 and 3, which is the beginning corner, and being the same property this day conveyed to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee.
