I, Lewis H. Keason

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 13 and 14 as shown on a Plat of the property of C. O. Berry, recorded in Plat Book M at Page 29, and being more particularly described according to said Plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast intersection of Berry Avenue and Hillcrest Drive, and running thence with Hillcrest Drive, N. 89-50 E. 120 feet to corner of Lot No. 15; thence with the line of said lot, S. 3-05 W. 176.6 feet to rear corner of Lot No. 33; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 33 and 32, N. 88-15 W. 100 feet to an iron pin in the East side of Berry Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of said Avenue, N. 3-05 E. 173.1 feet to the point of beginning.
