"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Chick Springs Township and in the City of Greer, lying on the West side of Morrow Street, known and designated as Lots. Nos. 18, 19 and 20 on a plat of property made for C.L. Chandler by A.E. Hoffman, dated March, 1918, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake on the western edge of Morrow Street, joint front corner of lots Nos. 17 and 18, and runs thence with the western margin of Morrow Street N. 11.30 E. 90 feet to a stake, joint front corner of lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the common line of lots Nos. 20 and 21 N. 78.00 W. 150 feet to a stake; thence S. 11.30 W. 90 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence with the common line of lots Nos. 17 and 18 S. 78.00 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of that property as conveyed to me by C.A.
