To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Hubert M. Ross, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Hubert M. Ross

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of Nine Thousand and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 9,000.00 )

Dollars, with interest at the rate of four (4%) six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

Fifty-Four and 54/100 - - - - - (\$ 54.54 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Hubert M. Ross

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said Hubert M. Ross in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being a portion of Lot No. 306, as shown on a plat of the property of Colonia Company, prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, February 1938, recorded in Plat Book "J" at pages 190 and 191, and being more particularly described, according to a survey of the property of Charles L. Welborn and Josephine G. Welborn prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, 19th of November, 1947, as revised 6th day of December, 1947, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Franklin Road, joint corner of Lots Nos. 306 and 307, and running thence with joint line of said lots, N. 32-34 E. 187.3 feet to an iron pin, now or formerly owned by Earl C. Hunter; thence N. 55-18 W. 117.3 feet to an iron pin on a 15 foot driveway; thence along said driveway, S. 27-26 W. 206.4 feet to an iron pin on Franklin Road; thence with said Franklin Road, S. 64-26 E. 99.4 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Helen H. Ross by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
