WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Three Thousand and No/100- - - - -
DOLLARS (\$ 3000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) ^{4 1/2%} per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and ^{AM}

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All ^{those} ~~the~~ certain piece/parcel^s or lot^s of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Eastern side of Wallace Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 19, and 20 on plat of Subdivision of E. H. Earle Property, made by Pickell & Pickell February 26, 1951, recorded in Plat Book Z at Page 191, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Wallace Street, at corner of lot 18, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 64-22 E. 161.6 feet to a stake; at corner of lot 2; thence with the line of lot 2, and continuing N. 25-38 E. 150 feet to a stake at corner of lot 21; thence with the line of said lot, N. 64-22 W. 161.6 feet to a stake on Wallace Street; thence with the Eastern side of Wallace Street, S. 25-38 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner."

Being a portion of the property conveyed to the mortgagors by Frank H. Earle by deed recorded in Volume 446 at Page 18.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
