"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southern side of Hillendale Circle, near the City of Greenville, being the Western portion of Lot 14, as shown on plat of property of J. M. Black, made by Dalton & Newes in December 1947, recorded in Plat Book S at Page 58, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of Hillendale Circle, at the corner of lot 11, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 17-15 E. 298.2 feet to a stake in creek; thence with the creek as a line, the traverses of which are N. 78-02 E. 4.2 feet and N. 61-02 E. 220 feet to a stake; thence leaving the creek in a Northerly direction 280 feet, more or less to a stake on Hillendale Circle; thence with the South side of Hillendale Circle, S. 75-42 M. 260 feet to the beginning corner."
