SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said James H. Styron

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont

in the full and just sum of \$1,197.97 Eleven Hundred Ninety Seven and 97/100

to be paid

Payable one year from date

with interest thereon from maturity

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
