(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND EOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Fourteen Hundred and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 1,400.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, known and designated as Lots Nos. 20, 21 and 22 on Plat of the Property of Bertie E. Burns, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in Plat Book G at Page 30, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of White Horse Road and Durham Street, and running thence along the Southern side of Durham Street, N. 78 E. 214.7 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 23; thence along line of Lot No. 23, S. 12 E. 151.5 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 14; thence S. 79-29 W. 278.7 feet to iron pin on the Eastern side of White Horse Road; thence N. 12 E. 157.8 feet to the beginning corner."
