It is also Covenanted and Agreed, that in case the said debt, or any part thereof, is established by any action for foreclosure or of debt on the said NOTE... that the said Mortgagee... in addition to the said debt shall also recover of the said Mortgagor... all attorney's fees incurred not to exceed Ten per cent. of the amount of this debt and interest, or in case the said Note... and mortgage shall be placed with an attorney for collection, all attorney's fees shall be due and collectable as a part of this debt and stand secured by this mortgage.
