consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

all that tract or lot of land in
Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
having according to survey made by W.A. Hester, November 21, 1928, the
following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on a stone of H. P. McGee tract and running north 4 E. 48.60
chains to a stone; thence N. 87 W. 23.33 chains to a stone O.M.; thence
S. 9.90 chains to a stone; thence S. 80 W. 0.23 links to a stone; thence
due south 21.50 chains to a concrete corner; thence S. 5 1/2 E. 15 chains;
thence N. 85 E. 18.50 chains to the beginning corner, said tract of land
containing 107 acres, more or less. Less, however, two acres described
as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Little Texas Road; thence due south 5 chains
to an iron pin at or near branch; thence S. 80 E. 4 chains to an iron pin;
thence due north 5 chains to Little Texas Road; thence down said road to
