SEND GREETING

Whereas, we, the said Charles E. Welch and Hazel H. Welch hereinafter called the mortgagor(s), in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, indebted to J. B. Hall hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Eleven Hundred
