All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about three miles West of Greenville County Court House, on the South side of Agnew Avenue, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 7 and 8 on a plat of property of Marsden, Inc., made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1943, recorded in the R.M.C.
