paid in full, said installments to be applied first in payment of

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole  
amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose  
this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, be-  
fore its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder  
should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases  
the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be

released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hall,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,  
Greenville County, state of South Carolina, known and designated as lot  
No. 19 according to plat of American Bank and Trust Company which plat  
is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book  
"F" page 44, near Anderson Road on the northeast side of Jamison Street,  
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Jamison Street, at  
the corner of lot No. 20 (which point is 107 feet S. 53-40 E. from Hill  
Street), and running thence with line of lot No. 20, N. 42-43 E. 200  
feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 8; thence with line of lot Nos.  
8 and 9, S. 53-40 E. 55 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 18; thence  
with line of lot No. 18, S. 42-43 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Jamison  
Street; thence with Jamison Street N. 53-40 W. 55 feet to the beginning  
corner.
